Official Rules of Contest

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THE CONTEST.

- All contestants on a team must be 18 or older to enter and compete. Team should arrive to the “contests” tent by 2:00PM EST on October 2, 2016.
- Entrants will be supplied with a vegetable peeler, but contestants are welcome to bring their own peeling instrument (peeler, knife, etc.) that will be inspected and approved by a contest official. No mechanical, automatic, or electronic peelers permitted.
- Teams will be given five minutes to peel as many potatoes as they can.
- Time will not be stopped for any reason. The contestant may take a break, but the clock will continue to run.
- Potatoes will be weighed for most pounds peeled within the 5 minutes, not the number of potatoes peeled.
- Potatoes will be inspected and must be peeled clean in order to qualify. Judge(s) will supervise the contest to make sure potatoes are completely cleaned – the skin of the potato must be completely removed and the potato cannot have more than three eyes left. Potatoes with peelings or more than three eyes will be disqualified from the total weight.
- The team with the highest weight of peeled potatoes will win; and the individual peeler with the highest weight of peeled potatoes will win.
- Contestants will be designated the same amount of work space, and may not use additional space.
- Pounds will be deducted for any potato skin peels not placed in discard bowl, and if work space is not kept clean.
- If a contestant should cut him/her, and bleeding occurs, he or she must willingly withdraw from the competition or be disqualified.
